Reaching Home Funding Allocation Discussion:

R. Warburton seconded,

That the remaining funds for 2022 - 2023 Reaching Home COVID-19 Funding be allocated as follows:

Housing First for Youth:	\$175,000
Housing First for Families:	\$350,000
Housing First for Adults:	\$336,953
Prevention & Shelter Diversion:	\$73,000
Indigenous Case Management:	\$99,000

That all programs focus on meeting the needs of people experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness and others who are among the most vulnerable, including: women and children fleeing domestic violence, seniors, young adults, Indigenous peoples, people with disabilities, people dealing with mental health and addiction issues, veterans, LGBTQ2+, racialized groups, Black Canadians, and recent immigrants or refugees.
