Approval of the Minutes

Committee requested that motions recommending approving expenditures for a Heritagethemed public signage initiatives and the repair of Bush Pilot's Monument be amended to include that that funds to be used are from Heritage Committee Reserve Fund.

Bush Pilot's Monument Repairs

Administration clarified that that the Bush Pilot's Monument is on territorial land.
 Administration noted that in order to recognize Bush Pilot's Monument as a Heritage Site, owner authorization is required.

Heritage Committee and Yellowknife Artist Run Community Centre Art Show

6. Committee noted that the Art Show is on public display from November 14 to 18, 2016 at the Yellowknife Artist Run Community Centre. Committee stated that so far it has been successful.

Heritage Week Theme 2017

- 7. Committee noted that Heritage Week is intended to promote heritage in Yellowknife. Committee further noted that this year marks Canada's 150 anniversary and the 50th anniversary of Yellowknife as the capital of Northwest Territories. Committee stated that Heritage Week is usually held in February. Committee further stated that rather than celebrating Yellowknife's history for one week, they would scale back and have a couple of days in February for the most popular event, which is an "Amazing Family Sunday" at the Prince of Wales Northern Heritage Centre and Wildcat Jam. Committee advised that Yellowknife was named the capital city on May 1, 1967 and they would like to have some aspect of heritage included into summer/fall events to celebrate the 50th anniversary. Committee suggested the theme to be #YK50; however the official name will be determined at a later date.

That the theme for 2017 Heritage Week be "50th Anniversary of Yellowknife as the Capital of Northwest Territories" with the more official name to be approved at a later date; and further that rather than celebrating Yellowknife's history for one week in February, that Committee celebrate a couple of days in February and include events in September to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Yellowknife as the capital of Northwest Territories.

Budget Update

9. Administration provided an update on the budget. Committee noted that they have an annual budget of \$35,000 for its regular activities. Committee further noted that over the last ten years, the Committee has expended its entire budget on Heritage Committee activities only this year. Committee stated that they spent \$32,305.83 so far with a few more invoices anticipated by the end of the year. Committee further stated they provide limited funding for groups with projects that celebrate Yellowknife's history and culture. Committee advised that the deadline to apply for the Heritage Committee Funding was November 10, 2016. Committee advised that they didn't receive applications for funding.
