1. The Chair called the meeting to order at 12:04 p.m.

<u>Presentation on Heritage Project Funding Application – Musicians of the Midnight Sun</u>

6. Committee heard a presentation from Mr. Pat Braden regarding a funding request for the development of an archival website, Musicians of the Midnight Sun, which will document local, regional and territorial musicians who played popular music in the 1960s and 1970s in Northern Canada.

Funding is requested in the amount of \$6,190.00 for the Musicians of the Midnight Sun project which would go toward the costs associated with recording, editing and obtaining interviews with seven identified Yellowknife musicians for the *Musicians of the Midnight Sun* website.

Action: Heritage Committee will deliberate on the funding application from Mr. Pat Braden for \$6,190.00 for the development of an archival website, Musicians of the Midnight Sun.

<u>Presentation on Heritage Project Funding Application – Festival on Franklin</u>

8. Committee heard a presentation from Ms. Stacie Smith regarding a funding request for the third annual Festival on Franklin, an event with the goal of promoting and revitalizing Yellowknife's downtown core.

Funding is requested in the amount of \$3,000.00 for the Festival on Franklin which would go toward payment of the musicians who will perform and the provision of volunteer supplies.



Action: Heritage Committee will deliberate on the funding application from Ms. Stacie Smith for \$3,000.00 for the Festival on Franklin to contribute to the payment of musicians and support of volunteers at the event.
