Funding Application Review: "Meet me at the Rex"

- 5. Administration noted that they received an application for Heritage Project Funding from Norman Glowach for "Meet me at the Rex. Administration further noted that Mr. Glowach is producing a musical that will be on stage May 25th at the NACC. Administration stated that "Meet Me At the Rex" is the story of how Mr. Glowach grandparents came to Yellowknife in 1939 and ran the Rex Café on Latham Island until 1996. Administration further stated that this musical tells the story of how their family came to Yellowknife and were part of this community. Committee noted that the application was eligible for funding.

That Committee approve the expenditure of \$2,900 for "Meet me at the Rex" Project.

Heritage Committee Art Collection Discussion

- 7. Committee discussed where to display a piece of artwork created by Erin Suliak that depicts Ruth Stanton owned by the City. Three options were discussed:
 - the hospital keeping the artwork and moving it to the new location;
 - the piece being relocated to the Yellowknife Guild of Crafts; or
 - offering the artwork to the Prince of Wales Northern Heritage Centre.

Committee suggested the piece stay with the hospital but that Administration reach out to Erin Suliak to determine her preference first.

Action Item: That Administration reach out to Erin Suliak regarding the artwork's relocation. If she is in agreement, Administration should give the artwork to the hospital to put up in the new location.

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Committee discussed the Bristol Freighter project and asked whether this could go back out to tender. Committee looked at how this project could be kept within budget and sought to clarify how much of the budget was available, taking into account approved, future projects. Committee also discussed changing the deadline for funding applications so that it aligns with the Grant Review Committee's deadline; to encourage applications and streamline the process. Committee and Administration discussed the possibility of two Heritage Committee members attending Grant Review Committee meetings so as to identify potential applications suitable for Heritage Funding.

Committee reviewed the 2018 Heritage Committee Strategic Review Summary prepared by Administration and concluded that it should be presented to Council.

Action Item: That Administration clarify the budget and whether the Intercultural Heritage and Placemaking Plan funds have been deducted.

Action Item: That Administration review opportunities for advertising Heritage Funding applications deadlines through the City's regular communication channels.

Action Item: That Administration bring forward a memorandum to Council, for information purposes only, outlining the Heritage Committees progress in relation to the Strategic Plan.

Action Item: That Administration extend an invitation to True North Rotary and Community Services to present to the Heritage Committee with an update.

would need to lead the Working Group.
