Overview of 2013 Heritage Projects

9. Administration updated the new committee members with a list of projects undertaken by the Heritage Committee this year, including: the purchase of a plaque for Back Bay as well as pop-up banners (used at Long John Jamboree and the Museum); Heritage Week themed on immigration; self-guided heritage brochures are being updated; an academic award or scholarship sub-committee was created; a visioning session is being planned for this year; the Wildcat Café opened; funding criteria for Heritage projects is to be revisited after the visioning session.

Committee Strategic Plan

10. Administration requested that Committee members email Mr. Ferri with ideas for possible consultants for the visioning session. Dates for the session were discussed. Administration will email out consultant prices to the Committee. Ms. McKeown would like to add onto the agenda for the visioning session that something be done to recognize veterans, such as a wreath at the cenotaph, on behalf of the Heritage Committee.

Progress on Sheave Wheel near City Hall

11. Administration noted that the City is willing to install the wheel. Mr. Vaydik to clean up the wheel and ready it for installation. Administration to look into a request for quotes for mounting the wheel on a concrete pad. Committee discussed delaying installation until a standard is set to have consistent messaging. Ms. Yuill, Ms. McKeown, and Mr. Kellett all volunteered to serve on a sub-committee for creating standards and criteria for all Heritage Committee messaging.

12. Administration reported that a Request for Quotes is out for the base (closing September 23, 2013).

13. Committee discussed eight proposed themes for the Heritage Week 2014.
